**Please note the correction to the following recipe from last month:**

**Ham Rolls**

24 1/8" slices of ham

**Filling:**

1 pkg. chopped frozen broccoli  
(cooked and drained)

**1 16 oz. cottage cheese (drained)**

1/2 c. chopped green pepper

1/2 tsp. dry mustard

1 beaten egg

1/2 pt. sour cream

salt to taste

Mix together. Place 1 Tb.

filling on each slice of ham.

Roll into quarter-sized rolls and  
hold with toothpick.

Bake 325° for 30 min. uncovered.

Drain ham rolls after cooking.

**Sauce**

1/2 pt. sour cream

2 cans cream of mushroom soup

Heat and pour over ham rolls.
