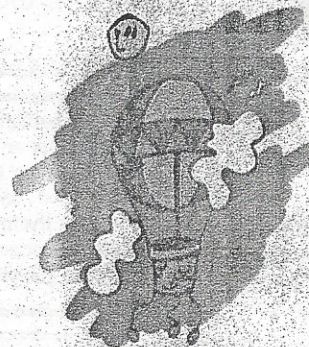

Coming weddings of Steven Leshar on the 18th and also Samantha Milne on the 26th of July. Our best wishes to all of these great young people.



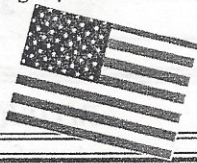
## WARD TEMPLE DAY
