BISHOPRIC MESSAGE

While serving my mission in Australia my grandmother passed away within 2 months of my arrival. I experienced sadness as I learned of her death via telegram. I remember the over-riding thought that she was in heaven now and looking down upon me. This was a powerful motivating tool for me to serve more diligently. As I listened to Elder Scott speak last week in General Conference ... I think we all could feel his spirit and relate to his emotions as he spoke of his wife and children who are on the other side of the veil. He mentioned how it was a powerful motivating factor for his family to live worthily to be with their mother and siblings again. There was no question about life after death from this great Apostle! There is no hesitation in his heart about the role of The Great Redeemer. He knows without doubt. I share my testimony ... without any doubt ... that there is life after death and that this great truth is just how the scriptures teach it. In April, 2010 Elder Scott said, "It is Easter morning, that holy day designated throughout all Christendom to commemorate the victory of Jesus Christ over death. His Resurrection broke what to that point had been the unvielding chains of death. He opened the path whereby each of Heavenly Father's children born to earth would have the opportunity to rise from death to live again". In 3 Nephi 25:2 we read: But unto you that fear my name, shall the Son of Righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth and grow up as calves in the stall. Elder Scott went on to say: "Members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints can understand more fully the breadth and depth of healing provided by His Atonement because we have the fullness of His doctrine. We realize that what He has willingly done with immense suffering and sacrifice will affect us not only in this life but throughout all eternity". My testimony of this doctrine has been strengthened not only in sacrament meeting, personal scripture study and prayer but also at many funerals. These sacred meetings are overflowing with the spirit testifying of the atonement and the gospel plan of redemption. Of course the atonement is more than the overwhelming blessing of overcoming death. Elder Scott said, "The prophet Lehi declared a profound truth when he stated: "Wherefore, redemption cometh in and through the Holy Messiah; for he is full of grace and truth. Behold, he offereth himself a sacrifice for sin, to answer the ends of the law, unto all those who have a broken heart and a contrite spirit; and unto none else can the ends of the law be answered" (2 Nephi 2:6-7). That scripture indicates that for the proud and haughty, it is as though there never were an Atonement made. One last quote from Elder Scott from this powerful talk: "Jesus Christ lives. He is our Savior, our Redeemer. He is a glorious, resurrected being. He has the capacity to communicate love that is so powerful, so overwhelming as to surpass the capacity of the human tongue to express adequately. He gave His life to break the bonds of death. His Atonement made fully active the plan of happiness of His Father in Heaven". We are grateful for our ward family. We love you all.
