The Holy Ghost

The Holy Ghost has many purposes. He is a comforter, a testifier of truth, and a sanctifier. Elder Bruce R. McConkie said the following –

"Truly, the Holy Ghost is a sanctifier, and the extent to which men receive and enjoy the gift of the Holy Ghost is the extent to which they are sanctified. In the lives of most of us, sanctification is an ongoing process, and we obtain that glorious status by degrees as we overcome the world and become saints in deed as well as in name."

Elder James Talmage states concerning the Holy Ghost -

"His office is that of enlightenment of the mind, quickening of the intellect, and sanctification of the soul."

Elder Bednar gave great counsel on this topic in the October 2010 general conference —

Fundamentally, all gospel teachings and activities are centered on coming unto Christ by receiving the Holy Ghost in our lives."

As a bishopric it is our desire that we all enjoy the blessings of the Spirit as we live worthy. Consider some of those blessings as shared through Elder Parley Pratt –

"The Gift of the Holy Ghost quickens all the intellectual faculties, increases, enlarges, expands, and purifies all the natural passions and affections, and adapts by the gift of wisdom, to their lawful use. It inspires, develops, cultivates, and matures all the fined-toned sympathies, joys, tastes, kindred feelings, and affections of our nature. It inspires virtue, kindness, goodness, tenderness, gentleness, and charity. It develops beauty of person, form and features. It tends to health, vigor, animation, and social feeling. It invigorates all the faculties of the physical and intellectual man. It strengthens and gives tone to the nerves. In short, it is, as it were, marrow to the bone, joy to the heart, light to the eyes, music to the ears, and life to the whole being."

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TIP:

How do you dry photos or important papers if there is flooding or other water damage? Do not try to separate items that are stuck together. Put these items, a few at a time(2-3) in a zip lock freezer bag and place in the freezer until stiff. Remove from freezer and let thaw for a couple of minutes. Gently separate the sheets that were stuck together and hang them up on a make shift line to dry. Hanging on a clothes line will insure drying evenly. Laying out on a table or other flat surface will only dry one side and the side other might start to mildew. Once dry you can put heavy objects on top of the papers or photos and it will help

Flatten them if needed.
