November 2018 – More Home-centered, Church-supported Worship

At General Conference in October, Church Leaders announced changes to support a more home-centered and Church-supported plan for members to learn doctrine, fortify faith, and foster heartfelt worship. Beginning in January 2019, the Sunday schedule followed throughout the Church will include a 60-minute Sacrament Meeting each Sunday, and after a 10-minute transition, a 50-minute class period. Sunday School classes will be held in this class period on the first and third Sundays, and priesthood quorums, Relief Society, and Young Women will be held on the second and fourth Sundays. Primary will be held weekly and will last 50 minutes.

In addition, Church Leaders are encouraging individuals and families to hold home evening and to study the gospel at home on Sunday – or at other times as individuals and families choose. A new resource, **Come, Follow Me - For Individuals and Families**, provides ideas for personal scripture study, family scripture study, and home evening.

These adjustments will be implemented in January 2019. The new **Come, Follow Me** resource will be distributed before the end of the year.

President Russell M. Nelson said, “As Latter-day Saints, we have become accustomed to thinking of “church” as something that happens in our meeting-houses, supported by what happens at home. We need an adjustment to this pattern. It is time for a home-centered Church, supported by what takes place inside our branch, ward, and stake buildings.

“Our efforts over these recent years to hallow the Sabbath – to make it a delight and a personal sign to God of our love for Him – will be augmented by the adjustments we will now introduce.”


Elder Quentin L. Cook said, “This Sunday schedule allows more time for a home evening and to study the gospel at home on Sunday or at other times as individuals and families may choose. A family activity night could be held on

Monday or at other times. To this end, leaders should continue to keep Monday evenings free from Church meetings and activities. However, time spent in home evening, gospel study, and activities for individuals and families may be scheduled according to their individual circumstances.”

He also said that in the home-centered, Church-supported portion of this adjustment, there is flexibility for each individual and family to determine prayerfully how and when it will be implemented.

Each family and individual in our ward has different circumstances. We need to prayerfully seek direction as to how we should each seek to enhance our study and teaching to one another. There is great flexibility for meeting informally, perhaps regularly with one another to enhance our study. We should seek to reach out to those to whom we minister and to our neighbors to meet in our homes and theirs to provide more rich opportunities to study and learn of one another and of the Savior.
