To be a disciple of Jesus Christ means to be a follower of Him.

Elder L. Tom Perry said: “The word disciple comes from the Latin [meaning] a learner. A disciple of Christ is one who is learning to be like Christ — learning to think, to feel, and to act [like] he does.”

We covenant each week as we partake of the ordinance of the Sacrament to “always remember Him.” As we remember, it is then critical to do what He commands us to do through the scriptures, the guidance of our leaders, and most importantly by the promptings of the Holy Ghost.

Elder Dieter F. Uchtdorf explained the process: “When we hear the transcendent truths of the gospel of Jesus Christ, hope and faith begin to blossom inside of us. The more we fill our hearts and minds with the message of the risen Christ, the greater our desire is to follow Him and live His teachings. This, in turn, causes our faith to grow and allows the light of Christ to illuminate our hearts. As it does, we recognize the imperfections in our lives, and we desire to be cleansed of the depressing burdens of sin. We yearn for freedom from guilt, and this inspires us to repent.”

Repentance and faith lead to baptism and then continuous renewal of the baptismal covenants through the Sacrament. Then, as Elder Uchtdorf says: “To uphold us in the desire to lead a purified and holy life, we are endowed with the baptism of fire — the unspeakable gift of the Holy Ghost, a heavenly Comforter who accompanies and guides us as we walk in the path of righteousness.

“The more we are filled with the Spirit of God, the more we extend ourselves to others. We become peacemakers in our homes and families,

we help our fellowmen everywhere, and we reach out in merciful acts of kindness, forgiveness, grace, and long-suffering patience.”

Applying these principles in our lives is a long process. Many obstacles, some of our making and many not, will be placed in our way. However, it is only by having faith in the Savior and seeking to do what He would do and what we would have us do that we can know Him and find the peace and joy that He promises us.

This is our testimony.


