June 2019 – Conversion to the Gospel of Jesus Christ

In the Bible Dictionary, we read that conversion “denotes changing one’s views, in a conscious acceptance of the will of God. If followed by continued faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, repentance, baptism in water for the remission of sins, and the reception of the Holy Ghost by the laying on of hands, conversion will become complete and will change a natural man into a sanctified, born again, purified person – a new creature in Christ Jesus. Complete conversion comes after many trials and much testing. To labor for the conversion of one’s self and others is a noble task.”

Being converted to the gospel of Jesus Christ is an ongoing process. As Elder David A. Bednar taught, “Conversion is an enlarging, a deepening, and a broadening of the undergirding base of testimony. It is the result of revelation from God, accompanied by individual repentance, obedience, and diligence. Any honest seeker of truth can become converted by experiencing the mighty change of heart and being spiritually born of God (Alma 5:12–14). As we honor the ordinances and covenants of salvation and exaltation (D&C 20:25), “press forward with a steadfastness in Christ” (2 Nephi 31:20), and endure in faith to the end (D&C 14:7), we become new creatures in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17). Conversion is an offering of self, of love, and of loyalty we give to God in gratitude for the gift of testimony.”

Through conversion, we act upon the impressions that we receive through the Holy Ghost. We truly want to change the way we act and we rely on the Savior. We use the atonement. We strive to be better. We “putteth off the natural man and becometh a saint through the atonement of Christ the Lord, and becometh as a child, submissive, meek, humble, patient, full of love, willing to submit to all things which the Lord seeth fit to inflict upon him, even as a child doth submit to his father.” (Mosiah 3:19)

Let us always strive to become more converted to the gospel of Jesus Christ and follow the example of Jesus Christ as he taught us in the Garden of Gethsemane when he said to the Father, "Not as I will, but as Thou wilt." Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ love each one of us. They know each of us personally. Jesus Christ will lift us up in times of sorrow, trials, or pain. Turn to the Savior and trust in Him, "For in his strength I can do all things."
(Alma 26:12)

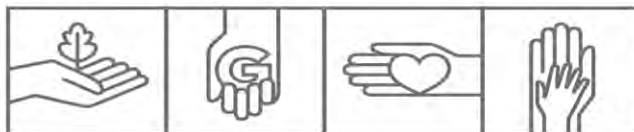
You can help by donating the following-
