# Indian Ridge Ward October 2019 - Follow the Prophet 

In General Conference last week, we had the blessed opportunity to hear from men who we recognize as prophets, seers, and revelators; modern day apostles of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Each of them were inspired individually to share faith building messages about the gospel of Jesus Christ. During the Saturday afternoon session, Elder Bednar shared an experience and three lessons he and his wife learned recently. He began by sharing a brief summary of a talk given by Elder Packer about crocodiles in 1976 after Elder Packer went on a trip to Africa. Elder Packer discussed spiritual crocodiles that lie in wait and attack unsuspecting victims.

Elder Bednar then shared a similar story about watching cheetahs pursuing topis (an antelope subspecies) on the plains of Africa. Elder Bednar noticed the cheetahs working in tandem to sneak up on the topis. One would sit still, in view of the topis while the other snuck forward, crouched, out of sight. Then the cheetahs would switch. The second would sit up tall to be seen and distract from the first that would crouch and begin moving out of sight.

Thanks to experienced sentinel topis standing on termite mounds diligently watching the cheetahs, the herd was able to escape. But the cheetahs continued their pursuit relentlessly until they were all out of sight of the Bednars.

There are many obvious lessons to be learned here, and Elder Bednar discusses them in his talk. I found it interesting through the rest of Conference to hear other references to distraction and deceit as a tactic of the adversary.

The leaders of this church, as seers, are standing watch and sounding the alarm for us. They can see the hidden crocodiles, or the crouching cheetahs, and can tell us of the dangers that we simply don't see before it is too late.

The part of the talk that really got my attention was when Elder Bednar said this immediately following the story of the cheetahs:
"That night, Susan and I had a memorable conversation about what we had observed and learned. We also discussed this experience with our children and grandchildren and identified many valuable lessons."

Elder Bednar could have easily omitted this from his talk and simply moved on to the three lessons he wished to share, illustrated by the cheetah story. Instead, Elder Bednar shares a hidden gem about parenting and teaching the gospel in the home.

The prophets will lead us on the covenant path to the Savior if we are ready to listen. Let us look for ways to follow and learn from them, even in the little things.
