






March Mental Health Check-in

This March the YW want to challenge the parents of the youth in the ward to check-in with the mental health of your children.

Here are examples of questions to ask your children:

- What's been stressing you out lately?
- What's something exciting that you're looking forward to?
- Do you feel like you have too much to handle, or do you think you are managing your time well?
- **Do you ever feel like you need someone to talk to, but don't know who to talk to?**
- What does your ideal day look like?
- **Are you eating, exercising, and sleeping well? How can I help you eat, exercise, or sleep better?**
- What's your favorite way to relax or de-stress?
- **I love you and care about you. What's the best way we can regularly connect about these things? Or how can I help/encourage you going forward?**

At our last mental health night, we talked about therapy and how to find the right therapist. Please reach out to your children and let them know that they can ask for help and you can help them find a therapist that works best for them.

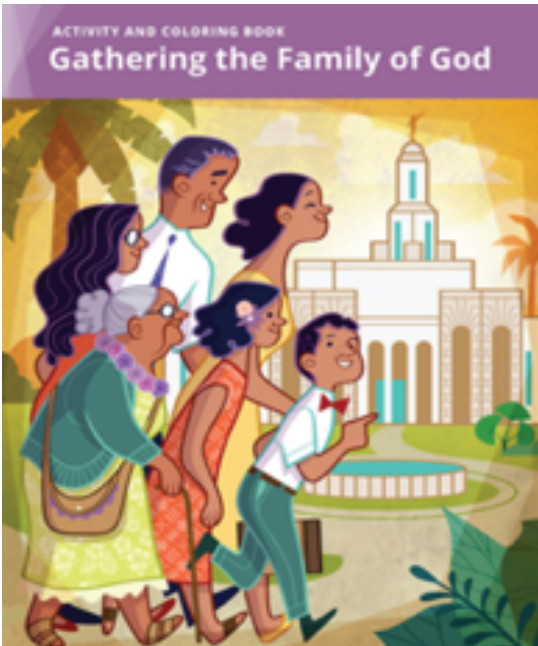
Primary
