






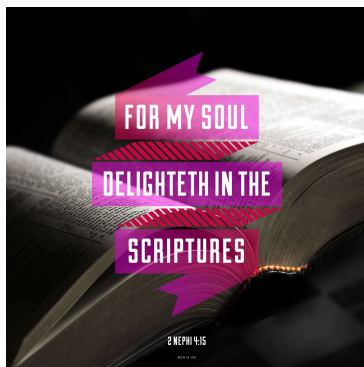
Primary
