

Ministering Interviews: Sisters, we will be starting to do Ministering Interviews this month. Starting this Sunday, we will be passing around a sign-up sheet for you and your companion to sign up for a time slot to meet with one of our RS Presidency. These will happen right after the second hour on the 2nd and 4th Sundays after Relief Society.

Our Purpose for Ministering Interviews:

- To council about the strengths, needs, and challenges of assigned sisters

- Discuss ways to help persons prepare to receive ordinances if needed

- Consider how Relief Society, Elders Quorum, Ward Council, and others can help

- How to help each sister feel Heavenly Father and Jesus love for them

Interviews are held at least once each quarter (every three months). Preferably, interviews are held in person and with both members of the companionship. Youth with ministering assignments should be included if possible" (General Handbook 21. Ministering)

The Purpose That Will Change Our Ministering (taken from the Liahona, January 2019)

While there are many purposes of ministering, our efforts should be guided by the desire to help others achieve a deeper individual conversion and become more like the Savior.

When we love others as the Savior does, we want to help them as He did. As the Good Shepherd, He is the ultimate example of meaningful ministering. In modeling our ministering after Him, it is important to remember that His efforts to love, lift, serve, and bless had a higher goal than meeting the immediate need. Certainly He knew of their day-to-day needs and had compassion on their current suffering. So He healed, fed, forgave, and taught. But He wanted to do more than take care of today's thirst (John 4:13-14). He wanted those around Him to follow Him (Luke 21:22), know Him (D&C 132:22-24), and reach their divine potential.

What Can We Do? If our purpose is to help others become more like the Savior, it will change how we minister. Here are some ways this understanding can guide our efforts to minister.


1. Pray For Guidance. Pray with your ministering companion to know what your sisters need and how to minister unto them. Pray for your sisters and their families.

2. Connect Service With The Savior. For example, if a sister is sick, a meal might be helpful, but your simple expression of love coud be multiplied by your testimony of the Savior's love for them.

3. Focus On The Covenant Path. We can have an important role to play in helping others along that path as we help them keep their covenants and prepare to make future covenants. You could explain the next covenant to be made in their lives, or share ways to have a more meaningful experience renewing our covenants while partaking of the sacrament.

4. Invite And Encourage. Don't be afraid to invite them to follow the Savior and allow Him to help them reach their divine potential. This invitation can be life changing, when coupled with an expression of your confidence in them and your faith in

the Savior.
