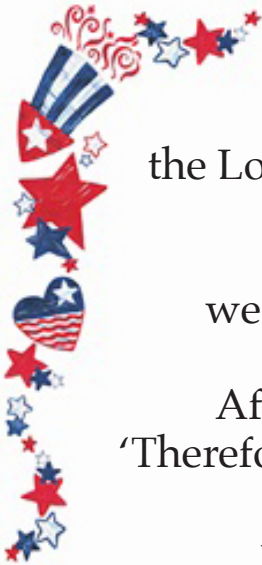

boldly testify of the Savior and of His restored church.

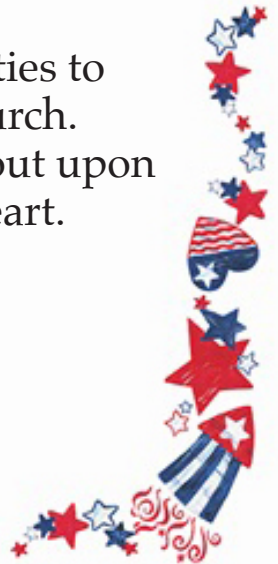
As you do so, His promised blessings will be poured out upon

Spiritual Thought

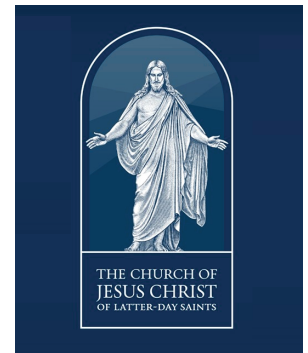

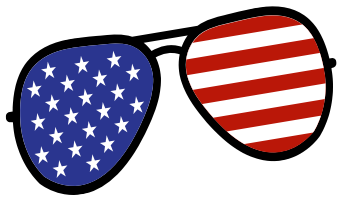
