Born March 5, 1930 to John Cameron Gilchrist and Velda Ethyl Brown Gilchrist. Dale's childhood was spent in different towns in Utah County including Lehi and Provo. He attended Maeser Elementary and Tanner Jr. High and graduated from Provo High School and LDS Seminary. After high school graduation, he worked for a time for the local newspaper, The Daily Herald, doing odd jobs. He also worked any other jobs that he could find to earn money to pay for BYU, including working in a

chicken processing plant. He never liked eating chicken after that.

Dale married the girl around the corner, Anne Taylor, September 20, 1950 in the Salt Lake Temple. They became the proud parents of 7 children, 5 girls and 2 boys. Dale's career was with a research and manufacturing company called Electro Controls. They manufactured stage lighting and controls for theatre and television. He held several positions there including National Sales Manager.

When Dale retired, he and Anne moved to Springdale, Utah where they lived for 19 years and then moved back to South Jordan to be closer to their family. As a devoted member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints he served in many positions including high council, bishopric, and temple worker.
