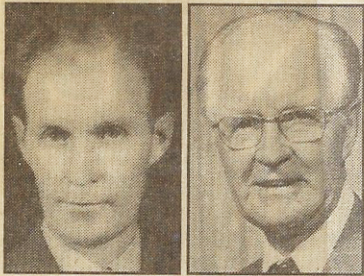


Van Neldon Lybbert
